

GALLON PRESENTED GOLD STAR AWARD: Dennis Gallon, associate vice president of instruction for the arts and sciences, was presented the Board of Trustees Gold Star Award. This award was given to Gallon in recognition of his outstanding efforts in editing a national report by AACJC's Urban Commission entitled "Regaining the Edge in Urban Education: Mathematics and Science." The report has been featured in several educational journals, including *The College Times*.

UNITED WAY CAMPAIGN ON THE RIGHT TRACK: Joan Hill. provost of South Campus, and this year's chairperson for the United Way Campaign, gave a rousing report on the success of this year's drive. A total of \$58,747 has been reported as of this date, a 54 percent increase over last year, and double the amount raised in 1986. A representative of the United Way remarked that this year's total goal for the city's educational institutions of \$118,000 is well on the way to being met, thanks to almost half that goal already raised by FCCJ. Plaques were then presented to the campus coordinators who assisted Hill in the campaign. An award for the highest percentage of contributions over goal was given to Open Campus. North Campus had the highest percentage of participation, and the career employees were recognized for the highest average contribution. The students at South Campus received an award for the most effective campaign, lauding the success of their Bovine Biscuit Bonanza, which raised in excess of \$650.
